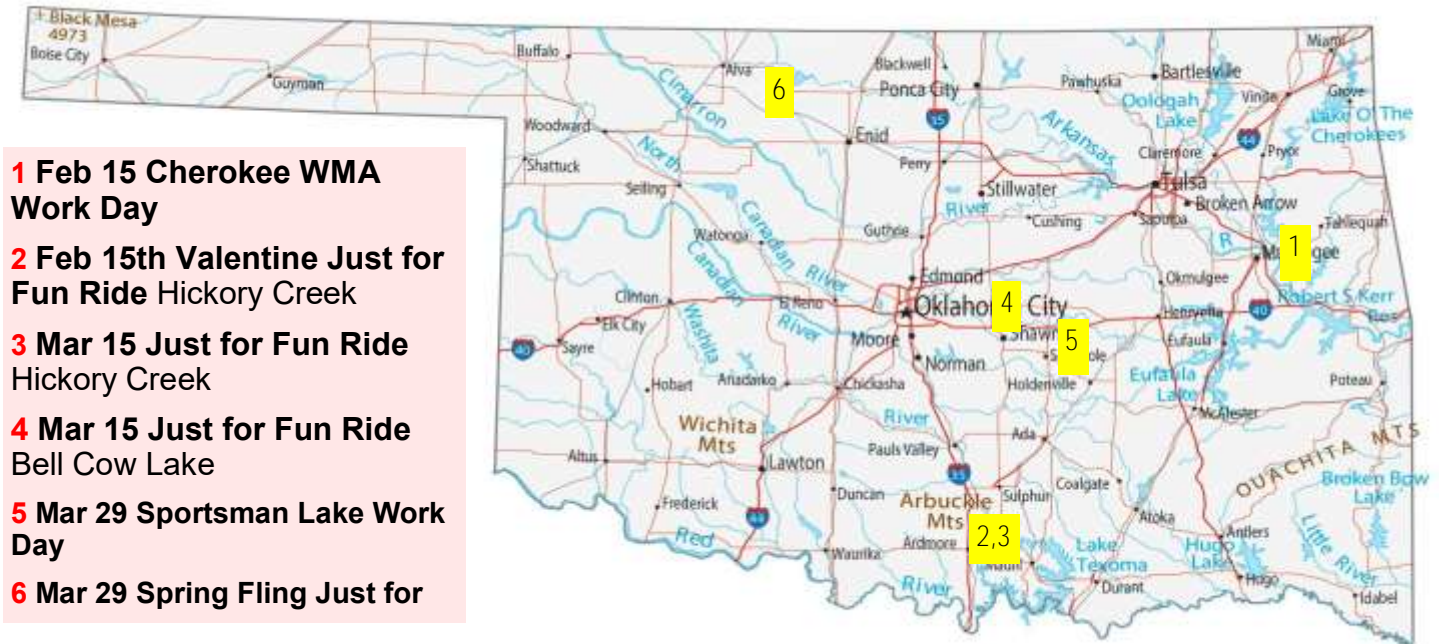

Member Spotlight Bonnie Nevels

Bonnie Nevels lives in Norman Ok, originally from North Dakota where she lived on a cattle ranch with her 5 older brothers and one sister. Her Dad started her love of horses with a Shetland pony in the 1960's. She fell in love and continued riding as she grew up but never had a saddle until she started riding barrels with her favorite horse Foxye. She had to walk 2 miles every day to care for Foxye even though the winters were cold and hazardous.

In 1976 she enlisted into the US Air Force and sold her horse and tack. She married BJ in 1978. They adopted 2 children, Brady and Bailey. They moved to 10 acres in Norman in 1996. Her boss raised ranch cow bred Quarter Horses. He invited her to ride trails at Cap Rock Canyon it renewed her love of horses and she bought 3 horses so the kids could each ride.

Brady developed a genetic eye disease and started losing his eye sight, however his love of horses had started and he picked it up very quickly. Bonnie and her husband bought a Living Quarters trailer and the family camped and rode many miles throughout Oklahoma at Robbers Cave, Cedar Lake, Bell Cow, Heavens Gate, Prague, Stroud Lake, Seminole, and trails in other states too.

She heard about OETRA at some of the parks in Oklahoma and met many members. She said they were very welcoming and friendly. She became a member in 2022 and she and Brady still ride QHs. Brady lost his full vision at 16 but still rides his horses that Bonnie trust completely. She and Brady have even done parades.

Bonnie was an RN in ER and occupational nursing from 1991 until she retired in 2021. Bonnie taught the CPR class for OETRA at Fall Color Ride 2023.

Please welcome Bonnie Nevels.



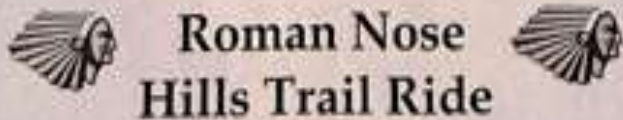
TRAIL KEEPERS
